

Poll conducted by Research Co. on Physician-Assisted Suicide in British Columbia - November 15, 2019

We'd like to ask you some questions about physician-assisted suicide. Generally speaking, do you support or oppose allowing a person to seek physician-assisted suicide in Canada if the conditions explained below are met?

Be eligible for health services funded by the federal government, or a province or territory (or during the applicable minimum period of residence or waiting period for eligibility).

Be at least 18 years old and mentally competent.

Have a grievous and irremediable medical condition.

Make a voluntary request for medical assistance in dying that is not the result of outside pressure or influence.

Give informed consent to receive medical assistance in dying.
